

Terms & Conditions | WIN A TRIP FOR TWO TO PARIS WITH PROFMED 2024

Please read these terms and conditions carefully. Participation in this competition constitutes your agreement to comply with these Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree with these Terms and Conditions, please do not participate.

The terms and conditions set out below apply to all participants in the Profmed Path 2 Paris competition 2024.

Profmed Path 2 Paris ("the Competition") is conducted by Profmed (Pty) Ltd ("the Company"), with REGISTRATION NO. 1194/FSP NO. 43918 and principal place of business at PROFMED PLACE, 15 ETON ROAD, PARKTOWN, JOHANNESBURG, 2193, South Africa, Tel: 0860 679 200.

1. All Participants must: be a natural person and be at least 18 (eighteen) years of age at the date of entry, be a citizen/legal resident of the Republic of South Africa, be in possession of a valid South African passport, reside in South Africa for the duration of the Competition period as well as for the period during which the prize draw and the booking of the prize takes place.
2. Employees, directors, prescribed officers, shareholders, and partners (and their family members) of Profmed, the applicable advertising, digital and marketing agencies for the Competition or any of their holding or subsidiary companies and their advertising and promotions agencies, are not eligible to participate in this competition. Profmed reserves the right to disqualify any participant who contravenes this rule.
3. The Competition entries will open on 1 February 2024 and entries will close on 31 March 2024. No entries received after 23:59 on 31 March 2024 will be considered. The duration of the Competition may be extended or curtailed at the discretion of Profmed.
4. One winner will be selected from the entries. The winner will be contacted by Profmed by 30 April 2024 via the contact details submitted with the entry.
5. The winner will be determined by a random draw and the results are audited by an independent auditor.
6. Should unforeseen circumstances prevent the draw from taking place on the set draw date; the draw will be moved to the next available date.
7. Profmed's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Should the winner not be contactable telephonically within 48 hours, the prize will be transferred to the next randomly selected entry.
8. Proof of eligibility, in the form of a valid South African passport, as well as proof of address and any other document which may be requested to enter the Competition, must be provided to Profmed upon request.

9. Profmed reserves the right to disqualify anyone entering the Competition that is not able to provide the requested documentation to Profmed within 72 hours of the first request for documentation.

- Men's 4 x 100m relay - round 1
- Women's 100m hurdles - repechages
- Men's 800m hurdles - repechages
- Women's shot put - qualification
- Women's heptathlon - 100m hurdles
- Women's heptathlon - high jump

It is the winner's responsibility to arrive at the airport on time and no flight bookings will be rescheduled or replaced should the winner and accompanying traveller miss their flights (connecting or international) for any reason whatsoever.

12. The winner and travel partner are required to have valid Passports.

13. The winner and travel partner will need to apply for the applicable travel Visa (this will be for the winner's own account). Should the Visa be rejected, the winner will forfeit the prize.

14. The following are not included in the prize and are for the winner's account:

Any costs related to extending the trip to other destinations.

Any additional baggage allowance costs.

26. DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

All personal information supplied by a participant shall be processed in accordance with South African data protection legislation and Profmed's Privacy Policy.

The Participant understands that the personal information given to Profmed, its associated agencies and the third-party service providers running the Competition in conjunction with Profmed will be used by Profmed for the purposes of:
